The petitioner/ Complainant Sri A. K. Laskar and PIO & I/C Extension Officer of Lowairpoa Dev. Block, Sri Abdul Jalil – both are present.

Since the BDO, Lowairpoa Dev. Block Karimganj and the 1st Appellate Authority did not pass any order the appeal petition is treated as a Complaint petition under **Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005** and is taken up for hearing accordingly.

The SPIO made a written submission dated NIL today by hand, which is entered in the case record.

The PIO, Lowairpoa Dev. Block Karimganj has made an oral submission that the Block office did not receive the original RTI petition dated 6.1.14. However the copy submitted by the Complainant / petitioner includes a Xerox copy of the Speed Post receipt from the Post Office.

Therefore, the petitioner's/ complainant's submission that he filed the RTI petition is admitted. The information sought for by the petitioner falls within the domain of RTI and functioning of the Block office..

Therefore, the Commission directs the SPIO, Lowairpoa Development Block to furnish the information to the petitioner subject to payment of required cost as may be necessary, as per procedure **within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order.**

With the above order, the complaint petition is disposed of.
