The complainant Smt. Manika Kutum is absent without any information or seeking leave of absence from the commission. The Public Authority is represented by Shri Indra Kumar Chetia, APS, Dy.S.P.cum SPIO in the office of the Superintendent of Police, Dhemaji, Assam and Shri Sanjay Rahang, Jr. Assistant, office of the Superintendent of Police, Dhemaji. The complaint petition is taken up for hearing ex-parte in the absence of the complainant.

The SP, Dhemaji has sent a written submission dtd 7.4.2015 stating inter alia that on 7th May, 2012 the sought for information was handed over to the applicant Smt. Manika Kutum with a forwarding letter dtd 02.5.12 personally by hand, which was received by her under her signature (undated). The SP has also enclosed the copy of her acknowledgment receipt along with the copy of information furnished to her. The OC, Jonai Police Station reported on 16.4.12 that no case was registered against the then OC of Jonai PS, Shri Punyeshwar Doley and no record was found on drawal of any departmental inquiry against Shri Punyeshwar Doley, stating further that therefore, the question of submitting final report u/s 173 Cr.PC did not arise. This report of OC, Jonai PS was given to the applicant vide letter dtd 2nd May, 2012 as mentioned above. The written submission of SP, Dhemaji dtd.7.4.15 is entered into the case records.

The SP, Dhemaji in his submission dtd 7.4.15 also mentioned that the same information was sent by post to the applicant in the address given by her on 25.7.13 but was returned indicating that the addressee was not available in the given address. Subsequently, on 23.9.13 the RTI reply was sent to her again by post in a new address given by her as mentioned in the submission made by the SP, Dhemaji.

In view of the above and in the absence of the complainant who could not be heard, her complaint petition is dismissed. However, in view of the serious nature of allegation that the then OC, Jonai Police Station Shri Punyeshwar Doly attempted rape on her, the complainant is free to approach other competent authorities like State Police Accountability commission for redressal of her grievances.

With the above order the complaint petition is disposed of.
