Perused the complaint petition dtd 31.12.12. It is seen from the case records that the complainant/petitioner Shri Khanindra Kalita submitted his RTI application before the Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara. The application was transferred by the Asstt. Project Officer and PIO, Goalpara, DRDA to the BDO, Matia Development Block with an instruction to furnish the required information to the petitioner on or before 28.2.12.

From the records it is seen that no information was furnished to the petitioner and he therefore, submitted an appeal petition to this Commission on 06.8.12. The first appeal petition was remanded by the Commission to the BDO, Matia Development Block, Goalpara. Getting no response from the first Appellate Authority, the petitioner filed the complaint petition before this Commission on 31.12.12. It is not known whether the BDO, Matia Development Block, Goalpara has meanwhile furnished the information to the petitioner.

The Commission therefore, directs the BDO, Matia Development Block to inform this Commission about action taken by him or whether he furnished the required information to the petitioner, if not already furnished, within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order.
