The petitioner/ appellant Sri Jon Bora as well as the public authority to be represented by the Secretary, Rajapathar Tiniali, “Lamps” (Co-operative Societies) Rajapathar, Karbi Anglong are absent without information.

The Second Appeal Petition dated 08.11.2012 is taken up for consideration on the basis of the available case records in the absence of both the parties.

From perusal of the case records, it is seen that the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Diphu had already issued a direction to the Rajapathar Tiniali “Lamps” (Co-operative Societies), Rajapathar to furnish the required information to the petitioner. It is also seen from the RTI petition dated 07.05.2011 that the required information is admissible under the RTI Act through the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies.

This Commission, therefore, directs the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Diphu, Karbi Anglong to fix a date within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order to hear both the parties and ensure furnishing of the required information to the petitioner within another 30 days from the date of receipt of this order.

With the above order the Second Appeal Petition is disposed of.
