The petitioners Sri Prasenjit Bhuyan and Sri Dinamoni Bhuyan are absent without information , nor have they prayed for deferment of todays' hearing. The public authority is represented by :- (1) Sri Vedanta Madhav, SPIO and S.E (Planning), Assam, Office of the Chief Engineer , PWD (Roads), Assam, Chandmari, Guwahati-1, and (2) Sri Ramani Kanta Barman, Sr. Asstt., of the same office.

The second appeal petition dated 7-8-2015 is taken up for hearing ex-parte in the absence of the petitioners.

From perusal of the case records, it is seen that the petitioners filed an RTI petition dated 17-11-2014 before the PIO of PWD, Border Roads and NEC works, Govt. of Assam. The SPIO and S.E (Planning) , PWD, who was present today submitted that the information sought for relates to the Chief Engineer, PWD (Roads) and he has in the meanwhile furnished all the required informations to the petitioners except copy of the relevant Peon Book by which the NITs were sent to the DIPR. The copy of the Peon Book could not be provided as it is an old document and could not traced out. The SPIO further submitted that the petitioners have been furnished with copies of the NITs, as published in the newspapers through DIPR. The SPIO and S.E (Planning) of the office of the Chief Engineer, PWD (Roads) submitted written statement dated 6th February, 2017 detailing the actions taken by him, as mentioned above, along with copies of informations already furnished to the petitioner.

It appears that except for the copy of the Peon Book mentioned above, other informations have been furnished by the PIO. It is also seen that since copies of the relevant NITs as published in the newspaper have already been furnished to the petitioner, copy of the Peon Book through which the NITs were sent to the DIPR for publication, does not appear to be of any great consequence. The SPIO and S.E (Planning) submitted a copy of his letter dated 25th February, 2015 addressed to the petitioners, enclosing the relevant documents furnishing him all the sought for informations except for the copy of the Peon Book , as mentioned above. This submission of the S.E(Planning) and SPIO is entered into the case records.

In view of the above, the second appeal petition dated 7-8-2015 is disposed of.
