1. The public authority to be represented by the SPIO of Deori Autonomous Council, Narayanpur, Lakhimpur is absent. However, he has sent a written submission dated 27-12-2017 stating that he is having some medical problems due to which he is unable to attend the hearing before this Commission today, for which he tendered apology. It has also been mentioned in his W/S that he has not received any further request from the petitioner Sri Dulal Bora for furnishing of any more information.

The appellant/petitioner Sri Dulal Bora is also absent, but he informed the Registry of this Commission over telephone that he has received all relevant information/ documents as sought for by his RTI petitions dated 19-9-2016 in respect of all the eight second appeal cases, numbering:- (i) KP(M)60/2017, (ii) KP(M) 62/2017, (iii) KP(M)97/2017, (iv) KP(M)96/2017; (v) KPIM) 94/2017; (vi) KP(M).95/2017; (vii) KP(M).61/2017 and KP(M) 98/2017 and that he is satisfied with the informations received.
