**O R D E R**  
**25/03/2022**

1. The petitioner Sri Nityananda Kalita has filed one RTI petition before the State Officer to Chief Secretary, Dispur, Guwahati on 23.7.2021 seeking the information about treatment of one Smti Lipika Kakati asking about the details of admission in GMCH, Guwahati and details of treatment including use of Zestr IG Injection, U Tryp IU Injection mentioning about septicaemia with septic shock diseases.
2. The Staff Officer to Chief Secretary, Chief Secretary's Office, Dispur forwarded the RTI petition to the Principal Secretary to the Govt. Of Assam, Health & Family Welfare Department, Dispur on 27.7.2021 and the same was again transferred to the Superintendent, GMCH, Guwahati on 25.8.2021.
3. The petitioner then filed 1<sup>st</sup> appeal before the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority/ Staff Officer, Chief Secretary, Dispur on 5.10.2021 and the same was again forwarded to the Principal Secretary to the Govt. Of Assam, Health & Family Welfare Department on 7.10.2021. The petitioner then filed 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal before the Commission on 24.2.2022 and accordingly the matter was taken up for hearing.
4. The petitioner is present.
5. The Public Authority to be represented by SPIO/ Superintendent of Gauhati Medical College & Hospital. However, the PIO & Dy. Superintendent of GMCH has submitted a written statement dated 23.3.2022 which is taken into records.
6. The petitioner was clarifying about the public interest in filing this RTI petition as he has already filed another 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal petition today on some mutation case of his alleged uncle.
7. When he was asked about the medical terminologies, he explained he does not know and these were told to him by another doctor.  
On the hearing, the petitioner stated that the deceased girl Smti Lipika Kakati has nobody else in her family and hence he wanted to know the details of her death.
8. The written statement of the PIO dated 23.3.2022 mentions that the patient died of Covid-19 Pneumonia with Septicemia with septic shock as per the hospital records on 2.6.2021 and her body was handed over to Sri Raju Kakati (Elder Brother of the girl).
9. It seems that the petitioner is lying about the details of the deceased family as he has mentioned earlier that the deceased girl has nobody else in her family.  
It can further be observed that the petitioner has vested interest in filing RTI petition as he has confessed that a doctor briefed him on medical terminologies and he has lied before the Commission that the deceased girl has nobody in her family.
10. Since the information is given by the PIO of Gauhati Medical College Hospital, Guwahati the Commission decides to dispose the case.
11. The case is disposed off.
